GUIDELINES:

- 1. This event is only for artists registered in Plein Air Santa Fe.
- 2. Canvas size no larger than 12" x 16".
- 3. Starting with a toned canvas is acceptable.
- 4. Volunteers will be in the Quick Draw area to stamp your canvas; you do not need to find a stamper ahead of time; they'll come to you during set-up time and the first few minutes of the Quick Draw.
- 5. All supports should be pre-mounted such that the stamp for the event is readily visible after framing.
- 6. Due to city code, do not set up in a spot that blocks public access, such as on a sidewalk or foot bridge.
- 7. Do not start any sketching on your canvas prior to the start time.
- 8. Entries for judging must be framed and on an easel in the designated judging area (TBA) by 12:30 PM. Have ready all frames and tools for securing pieces to frame. You may pre-drill frame in both directions for flexibility.
- 9. Bring artist bios, cards, or other information to share with potential customers.
- 10. The winning painting will be hung in the PASF exhibition at Gary Kim Fine Art Gallery, and will be subject to the same guidelines and sales arrangement as the juried show.
- 11.If a Quick Draw painting is sold on June 21st, please enact the sale through Gary Kim Fine Art Gallery. It will be subject to the same guidelines and sales arrangement as the juried show.

SCHEDULE:

9:30-10:00 Artists gather in designated Quick Draw location, along East Alameda between Cathedral Place and Delgado Street. Stampers will circulate to ensure all canvases are stamped.

10:00–12:00 Painting begins with sounding of bell/horn.

10:00 – 12:00 Timed painting period.

11:30 Bell/horn will indicate 30 minute warning.

12:00 noon Bell/horn will indicate end of painting period. Please honor the system.

12:00–12:30 Artists will have 30 minutes to frame artwork and set up easels in the judging area.

12:30 Judging begins.
